Eczema Bleach Bathing



Bleach baths assist in reducing the number of bacteria on the skin so the eczema does not get infected. Regular bleach bathing may help manage eczema in children and adults, resulting in reduced inflammation and itch. Be assured that the chemical concentration of this very diluted bleach bath will be lower than that of a public swimming pool.

You will need:

- Bath tub or baby bath
- Lukewarm water
- 10L household bucket
 - Unscented Household White King bleach – 12mL per 10 litres of water
- Bath oil 1-2 capfuls per bath if recommended
- Pool or table salt 1/3 cup per 10 litres of water if recommended
